An evening under the Indian Summer stars will welcome guests for non-stop line dancing, beginning with instruction, followed by a night of great music from a fabulous western band accompanied by a classic western BBQ catered by the highly rated Naples Rib Company serving smokehouse BBQ ribs, chicken, steak and all the fixins.

Produced by the talented creative team at Balboa Island Museum led by executive director Tiffany Pepys Hoey, working in conjunction with the party pros from O.C. Elite Productions, the night will be filled with carnival games of chance, open bar, a great silent auction featuring travel, dining, and unique opportunities, all proceeds benefiting the year round, free admission to all, exhibits and programs at Balboa Island Museum.
