#### Daisy Girl Scouts: 1 Hour Program

To complete this badge, scouts will come prepared to tell a personal story about a family holiday or event, know what countries their family came from and bring an object or a photo or drawing of an object that was “handed down” within their family. ##### **Playing the Past**
